

Rebecca Elwell - Lymphoedema Nurse Specialist

Rebecca has been working in the treatment of lymphoedema for 17 years and has strong national and international links. She was chair of the British Lymphology Society from October 2003 to October 2008 and is involved with the International Lymphoedema Framework Project. Rebecca also presents regularly at national and international conferences.

Rebecca has many publications to her name, including a commissioned series of rare case articles for the Journal of Lymphoedema. She is also involved in a number of research projects which focus on the management of lymphoedema.

Rebecca completed her MSc in Lymphoedema in 2012, and as part of this carried out a randomised controlled trial in the use of deep oscillation therapy for breast cancer related lymphoedema. She is a fully qualified Casely-Smith and Leduc MLD therapist.

Rebecca has won a number of awards including the Highly Commended Award in the Patient Involvement category of the Innovations in Lymphoedema and Chronic Oedema, Wounds UK award ceremony in 2009 and more recently she was runner up in the acute nurse category in the Pioneers of Care awards 2013.
